Baile nan Gàidheal | Highland Village is Nova Scotia's Provincial museum and folk life centre for Gaelic language and culture. Each year, Nova Scotians, and visitors to Nova Scotia, engage with the Highland Village for transmission and experiential presentation of Nova Scotia Gaelic culture and language, by way of first person (role playing) animation, special programs, workshops, hands-on activities, and outreach. The Highland Village is seeking individuals to join its team in the following student positions:

Heritage Animator/Interpreter (Student)

The Student Heritage Animator, in costume, provides informative, effective and entertaining interpretation of Nova Scotia's Gaelic heritage and culture through first person (role playing) interpretation; demonstrations of language, culture, crafts, and folklife; and participation in "living history" and cultural and interpretive programming. Applicants must have the ability to explain relevant content in a clear and entertaining way; comfortable speaking in front of groups and interacting with people of all ages and backgrounds; general knowledge of the Gaelic Nova Scotia story and identity; demonstrated skill in the area of interpersonal skills and teamwork; gives and takes constructive feedback; strong communication skills (both oral and written); and friendly, courteous and outgoing personality. Cultural and heritage skills are assets. *Salary is \$10.85/hour, 35 hours per week for up to 14 weeks ending August 25, 2017.*

Animator/Musician (Student)

The Animator/Musician, in costume, provides knowledgeable and courteous interpretation of the music tradition of Gaelic culture, informative, effective and entertaining interpretation of Nova Scotia's Gaelic heritage and culture through first person (role playing) interpretation; demonstrations of language, culture, crafts, and folklife; and participation in "living history" and cultural and interpretive programming. Applicants must be able to interpret the Nova Scotia's Scotch music tradition (pipes/fiddle) to visitors and provide music for céilidhs and other interpretive activities. Applicants must also have the ability to explain relevant content in a clear and entertaining way; comfortable speaking in front of groups and interacting with people of all ages and backgrounds; general knowledge of the Gaelic Nova Scotia story and identity; demonstrated skill in the area of interpersonal skills and teamwork; gives and takes constructive feedback; strong communication skills (both oral and written); and friendly, courteous and outgoing personality. Cultural and heritage skills are assets. *Salary is \$13.00/hour, 35 hours per week for up to 14 weeks ending August 25, 2017.*

Curatorial Assistant - Research (Student)

Working with staff, the student will support the continued evolution and growth of the Highland Village interpretive animation program through the development of an interpretive resource manual for one interpretive building, which will be used as a template for the preparation of manuals for each of the other buildings. The student should be enrolled in a Celtic Studies, Museum Studies, or History program at a Canadian University and be eligible for the Young Canada Works in Heritage Institutions Program, have documented experience in historical research, report writing, good time management skills, be able to work with others and alone, and must be able to provide a clean criminal record check if selected. Knowledge of, and interest in, Nova Scotia Gaelic culture and identity would be an asset. *Salary is \$15.00/hour, 35 hours per week for up to 14 weeks ending August 11, 2017.*

Curatorial Assistant - Collections (Student)

Working with Highland Village staff in preparation for a province wide evaluation project, the student will assist with an inventory of 11 period buildings and storage areas containing artifacts, containing up to 3800 artifacts, assist in preparing inventory sheets, enter and update locations in the Provincial database, continue our reorganization project by photographing and documenting artifacts, and creating custom housing for selected artifacts. The selected artifacts will be boxed and placed on shelving. The student should be enrolled in a Museum Studies program at a Canadian University and be eligible for the Young Canada Works in Heritage Institutions Program, have documented experience with artifact handling, excellent communication skills, experience with digital photography, good time management skills, be able to work with others and alone, and must be able to provide a clean criminal record check if selected. Knowledge of, and interest in, Nova Scotia Gaelic culture and identity would be an asset. *Salary is \$15.00/hour, 35 hours per week for up to 14 weeks ending August 11, 2017.*

All applicants must be current full time post-secondary students returning to full time studies in the fall, or current high school students attending post-secondary studies in the fall.

Feumaidh an neach-beòthachaidh a bhi fiosrachail, san fharsaingeachd, mu stòiridh Ghàidheal na h-Albann Nuaidhe, sgileil cinnteach mar dhuine a tha gnòmhachail aig ire eadar-pearsanta agus mar bhall de sgioba-obrach a' Bhaile. Feumaidh an neach seo a bhi deiseil gus comhairle a thoirt agus a ghabhail, làidir ann an comasan conaltraidh, (facal a' bheòil agus sgriobhadh), agus fosgarra, còir am measg cuideachd. Bithear sgilean dualchasach `gam measadh buannachdail. *Tha an turasdal aig ire \$10.85 an uair/35 uairean an t-seachdain. Mairidh an dreuchd fad 14 seachdainean gus an coigearm là air fhichead dhan Lùnasdal.*

Neach-beòthachaidh Ciùil (Oileanach)

Bidh an neach-beòthachaidh ciùil, an eíeadh àrsaidh, a' solarachadh mìneachaidd air tradaisean ciùil agus nòs is dualchas Ghàidheal na h-Albann Nuaidh. Feumaidh an neach seo a bhi eòlach, éifeachdach, spòrsail tro mhodh beòthachaidh a' cheud phearsa agus comasach air taisbeanaidhean canain, cultair agus làimh-chiùird a chuir air n-adhart. Bidh aig an neach seo ri ghabhail an sàs am prògramannan eachdraidh bheò agus taisbeanaidhean eile. Feumaidh tagraichean a bhi comasach air eachadraidh chiùil `san nòs Ghàidhealach a mhìneachadh do luchd-tadhail, agus inneal-chiùil a shéinn (a' phiol, air neo an fhidheall) aig céilidhean agus tachartasan beòthachaidh eile. Feumaidh tagraichean a bhi comasach air cuspairean buinteanan a mhìneachas gu soillear ann an dòigh a bhios abhaideach, comhartail agus a bhi eadar-gníomhachail ann a bhi a' bruidhinn mu choinneamh bhuidhnean agus am measg caochladh dhaoine aig gach aois. Neach-cuideachaidh Curaideach - Rannsachadh (Oileanach)

Feumaidh comasan dearbhte a bhi aig an oileanach air rannsachadh eachdraidh, aithisgean a sgriobhadh, ùine obrach a riaghlaidh gu math, a bhi ag obair ann an cuideachd dhaoine eile agus fo c(h)eann fhéin. Feumaidh cunnadas glan, neo-lochdach a bhi `ga thoirt seachad aig an oileanach, mas ann air thaghadh a bhios e/i. Bidh eòlas air dualchas Ghàidheal na h-Albann Nuaidh, air neo

suim air ionnsachadh mu dheidhinn, `ga mheasadh mar mhaoin. *Tha an turasdal aig ire \$15.00 an uair/35 uairean an t-seachdain. Mairidh an dreuchd cho fada ri 14 seachdainean gus an t-aonamh là deug dhan Lùnasdal.*

Neach-cuideachaidh Curaideach - Cruinneachaidhean (Oileanach)

Le bhi ag obair còmhla ri luchd-obrach los faighinn deiseil airson pròiseagt measaidh thaighean-tasgaidh a dh'éiricheas air feadh na mór-roinn, bidh an t-oileanach a' cuideachadh gus maoin-cunnadas a dheanaadh air gnothaichean àrsaidh - air an àireamh suas ri 3,800 dhiubh gu léir - `s iad air an tasgadh ann an aon togalach àrsaidh deug agus àiteachan tasgaidh eile a bharachd. Bidh an t-oileanach a' cuideachadh le duilleagan cunnadas a chur an òrdugh, aithneachadh an àiteachan tasgaidh eile suideachaidh far an gabh an gnothaich-àrsaidh faighinn `san àm - agus sin a chlàradh ann an stòr-data na Mór-roinn, cur ri leantail air pròiseagt an ath-eagrachaidh le dealbhannan agus sgriobhainnean de gnothaichean àrsaidh a chur an òrdugh agus modhannan tasgaidh fa leth a chruthachadh airson ghnothaichean àrsaidh air an sònachadh. Bidh gnothaichean àrsaidh, air an comharrachadh ann, `gan cur ann am bogsaichean agus `gan càradh air sgeipichead. Tha còir aig an oileanach a bhi air chlàradh ann am prògram Foghlam Taigh-tasgaidh aig oilthigh Canaideanach agus airidh air roghainn aig *Young Canada Works in Heritage Institutions Program*. Feumaidh fiosrachadh dearbhte a bhi aig an oileanach air làimhseachdh gnothaichean àrsaidh, conaltradh air leth a dhèanadh, sgilean mu dhealbhannan camara dideatach, ùine obrach a riaghlaidh gu math, a bhi obair ann an cuideachd dhaoine eile agus a bhi ag obair fo c(h)eann fhéin. Feumaidh cunnadas glan, neo-lochdach a bhi `ga thoirt seachad aig an oileanach, mas ann air thaghadh a bhios e/i.
