Duties: Reporting to the Manager of Visitor Experience, the Co-ordinator of Animation & Programs is responsible for the day to day coordination and supervision of resources to support the delivery of animations, programs, and special events, including, but not limited to, staff, volunteers, supplies, and costumes. The Co-ordinator of Animations & Programs also animates and delivers programs as required. For the 2024 season, the Co-ordinator of Animations and programs will also serve as the Costume Co-ordinator. A full job description is available upon request.

Qualifications: Demonstrated experience in managing people (staff and volunteers) and coordinating programs and events; successful completion of high school or relevant life experience; can problem solve and quickly adapt to changing situations; has an ability to explain things in a clear and entertaining way and through first person animation; ability to research and develop first person characters (personas & related stories); comfortable speaking in front of groups and interacting with people of all ages and backgrounds; knowledge of the Gaelic Nova Scotia story and identity; knowledge of local, Nova Scotian, and Canadian history; demonstrated strength in the area of interpersonal skill and teamwork; gives and takes constructive feedback; strong communication skills, both verbal and written; demonstrated ability to interact well with people with tact, listening skills, and positive attitude; friendly, courteous and outgoing personality; knowledge or interest in Gaelic language, culture and history; cultural and folklife skills are assets (e.g. Gaelic singing, fiddle playing, spinning, weaving, cooking, etc.); and basic computer skills, i.e. word processing, e-mail, internet, etc.

Terms of position: This is a full time, seasonal position (40 hours/week, April to October) for the 2024 season, with potential for renewal. Wage scale is \$24.63-30.20 – compensation dependent on successful candidate's experience. Group benefit package available.
