4.4 - AWARD OF MERIT POLICY

1.0 The Policy

- 1.0.1 The award is known as “The Nova Scotia Highland Village Society Award of Merit.”
- 1.0.2 There should normally be only one award presented each year, although a second may be presented under special circumstances.
- 1.0.3 The award shall be presented at the annual Highland Village Day concert.
- 1.0.4 It shall be awarded to an individual or group who has made a significant contribution to the Highland Village and/or Scottish Gaelic culture in Nova Scotia.
- 1.0.5 Nominations for the award should be on the agenda for the first board meeting in the New Year.
- 1.0.6 Nominations can be made by anyone.
- 1.0.7 Names of nominees will be carried forward for the following year.
- 1.0.8 The recipient will be decided by the Nova Scotia Highland Village Society Board of Trustees.
